



WHAT DO THE REALTORS® OF ARIZONA POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE (RAPAC) TRUSTEES DO?

The REALTORS® of Arizona Political Action Committee (RAPAC) Trustees are responsible for administering the political activities of the Association. The Committee:

- Promotes the improvement of government by encouraging involvement by REALTORS® and others to take an active part in governmental affairs.
- Educates REALTORS® and others on the nature and actions of their government, important political issues, and the positions of office holders and candidates for elective office.
- Supports candidates for election to legislative and executive offices of Arizona, and provide funds for national political committees and local political action committees.
- Cooperates with national, other state and local political action committees when in the best interests of RAPAC.

The Committee is made up of REALTOR® members representing each region around the state.

RAPAC funds collected are disbursed to candidates at the discretion of the Trustees of the Committee. The Trustees review positions of office holders and candidates for elective office and decide which candidates to support based on their previous support of or their position on REALTOR® issues.
