Quick Tips for Attending the Board of Directors Meeting:

 amplify every breath, every snap of your jaw, every click and hiss of the words you pronounce and can create annoying
 feedback, popping, and screeching.
- Don't talk too far away from the mic you want to make sure the mic picks up your voice and the attendees can hear
 you.
