






## Breakdown of traffic by device (% of pageviews)



This is a common entry page, as the login fields are used a lot on this page




## AARonline.com Manage Risk

Quick Links are more popular than the page content itself. (3)





### AARonline.com Manage Risk - Sample Forms

- 3. Links to forms (Residential Resale Transaction Form, Property Management Forms, Agency/Employment Forms, etc)






### AARonline.com Resolve Disputes

### AARonline.com Voice at the Capitol


Again, not a very heavily trafficked area of the site.





## AARonline.com Web Survey

- Users value Business Tools, Education, Legal Hotline, and Risk Management above all else
- Leadership/committee info and Find a REALTOR® are the least important features for users
- Users were not satisfied with the mobile-friendliness of the site
- ~20% of respondents visit AARonline.com several times a week or daily
- Overall 95% of the respondents are "Very Satisfied" (53.3%) or "Somewhat Satisfied" (42.7%) with AARonline.com



### Comparison with other REALTOR® Association sites

- AAR's navigation is confusing and cluttered compared to other Association sites.
- The design of AARonline.com is several years dated.
- AAR's site has more content than most other state's sites, making 1-to-1 comparisons difficult.
  - AAR is an information resource, as compared to some other Associations which have less content and are more consumer facing




### Findings Overview

- The design of the site is dated






