In 2015, our portfolio did not perform as well as we hoped it would: and the board paid our just 4% (instead of the 5% our policy allows) in order to protect our investment assets. In 2016, we saw a strong performance that continued into 2017. Our five-year average return is far above 8% target level, reaching nearly 10%!
