November 6, 2018 General Election Results: **Proposition 126 Won!!! With 65% of the vote** (1,055,596 votes!)

SINGLE SIGN-ON

In March our newest benefit as members of the Arizona REALTORS, Single Sign-on was launched. Single sign-on is a dashboard designed to help members save time and improve their security, and gives members one central location in which they can access the websites and applications they use the most in their business every day. And you only need to use one password! Basically the need to keep track of different passwords for each website or application has been eliminated! If you haven't signed up, please do so today!

*If there are members who have not enrolled yet, ask them to do it today. Even if they are not in front of a computer, they can do it on their phones!

The easy enrollment steps:

- 1. Ask them to open a web browser and go to dashboard.azrealtorsso.com.
- 2. Their user name is their NRDS ID and their password is their last name (first letter is capitalized).
- 3. Three things will happen; they will be asked to:
 - a. agree to the user agreement
 - b. provide the answers to 3 security questions, and
 - c. create a new password.

That's it – they are enrolled!

Additionally, brokers can also have a presence on the Arizona REALTORS® SSO dashboard; there are three ways to participate, one of which is FREE!
