CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



ROAD, SIDEWALK AND GUTTER IMPROVEMENTS IN PROGRESS! NO ROADWORK 4TH OF JULY WEEKEND

Broadway construction is expected to be completed by July 2nd. The final product will contain a curb and gutter on both sides of road. A runner-friendly sidewalk will be completed on the North side with bike lanes on both sides of the roadway. The entire road will be resurfaced and striped.

Other resurfacing projects on select roadways are planned to commence shortly and expected to be completed by July 10th including:

- Main Street from Broadway to Cement Plant Road
- Clarkdale Parkway
- Old Jerome Highway

All of these will be striped for bike lanes. Clarkdale Parkway will also receive shoulder improvements to allow for pedestrian access.

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER FOR THE AUGUST 4TH PRIMARY ELECTION

JULY 6th -Last day to register to vote JULY 8TH - First day to cast an early ballot JULY 24TH at 5pm - Last day to request early ballot by mail
JULY 31ST - Last day to vote early in person

Clark Memorial Clubhouse at 19 N. Ninth St, Clarkdale AZ is a voting center for the August 4th primary election. For other voting center locations, see the Yavapai County Elections website below.

2020 CENSUS UPDATE

Census takers are in neighborhoods now and are identified with a badge, phone & computer. They are currently only allowed to leave a questionnaire at your door or gate for you to fill out. Please respond by phone, mail or internet. Local libraries are available to assist with filling out Census forms. A Census worker will never ask you for a Social Security number, any form of ID, money, anything on behalf of a political party or banking information.
