ARIZONA HOUSING FUND

CONSUMER FLYER: A consumer directed flyer is now available on aaronline.com. To make it easier for consumers to understand what the Arizona Housing Fund is and how it works, we now offer two flyers, including a "client match flyer" stating "your agent will match your contribution to the Arizona Housing Fund at closing." Both flyers give agents the opportunity to upload their logo.

- The goal of the Arizona REALTORS[®] is to give every buyer and seller the opportunity to voluntarily donate \$25 (or more) to the Arizona Housing Fund at close of escrow to help the homeless.

LEGISLATIVE & POLITICAL AFFAIRS

RAPAC REMINDER: "RPAC's mission is to identify candidates for elected office on the local, state, and national levels who will work with REALTORS[®] to promote and protect the American Dream of property ownership. Candidates who receive support from RPAC *are not selected based on their political party or ideology, but solely on their support of real estate issues."*

RAPAC AUCTION: The annual Arizona REALTORS[®] Auction will be held online beginning Monday, March 29, 2021 at 9:00 am and will run through Friday, April 02, 2021 at 12:00 pm.

We have many great auction items this year, including some fun new items we haven't had in any of our previous auctions! In addition to the auction, we will be raffling off a Microsoft Surface Pro package valued at \$2,000! The raffle ticket prices will start with 1 ticket for the RAPAC fair share amount of \$30.

The auction and raffle will be accessed through the Legislative and Political Affairs section of aaronline.com, by clicking on the RAPAC Auction & Raffle button. To access the auction site members will need to be logged into Single Sign-On.

LEGISLATIVE SESSION: This legislative session the Arizona REALTORS[®] Legislative agenda will be focused on furthering legislative policies and ensuring that landlords, tenants, and private property owners are protected when COVID-19 relief legislation is drafted.

So, what are the REALTORS[®] doing for you?

- <u>SB1310</u> (Shope) establishing a REALTOR[®] Specialty License Plate, as well as supporting affordable housing efforts in the state, passed unanimously through the House Transportation Committee last Wednesday and now heads to the House Floor before reaching the Governor's Desk.
- On the defensive front, the REALTORS[®] have been working hard, successfully working with bill sponsors to amend <u>HB2128</u> (Osborne) and <u>HB2759</u>(Grantham) to protect license fees and rulemaking. However, not all opposition is that easily resolved.
- After Senator David Gowan failed to adopt the REALTORS[®] amendment to his bill, <u>HB1598</u>, which would allow transaction coordinators to work for more than one broker and thus creating significant liability and conflict-of-interest concerns, the REALTORS[®] elevated of opposition by issuing a Call For Action asking Broker members to call their Senators and urge them to vote NO on SB1598 as it stands.
- Lastly, the REALTORS[®] are also monitoring bills around short-term rentals, homestead exemptions, HOAs and evictions to ensure that our core principles are protected.

We may not always agree with legislators, but your investment in RAPAC has allowed us to foster long-lasting relationships with elected leaders and find solutions when we do disagree. For more information on bills visit <u>www.AZleg.gov</u>.

RESIDENTIAL BUYER'S INSPECTION NOTICE AND SELLER'S RESPONSE: The Residential Buyer's Inspection Notice and Seller's Response Workgroup, chaired by Tahona Epperson, has prepared a revised draft of the Residential BINSR to be considered for future release. On March 16th we circulated to the Loop the revised draft for review and comment and asked members to take the time to review the proposed form and provide us with their input. All comments should be submitted to Jan Steward at <u>jansteward@aaronline.com</u> no later than Monday, March 31st. Please remind members that while all suggestions will be reviewed and discussed by the Workgroup, not all suggestions will be implemented.

LISTING AGREEMENTS: By way of a Workgroup chaired by Mimi Lundy, the Arizona REALTORS[®] drafted the following three NEW forms: (1) <u>Residential Listing Contract</u> <u>Exclusive Right to Sell/Rent</u>; (2) <u>Residential Listing Contract Exclusive Agency</u> (collectively "Listing Agreements"); and (3) <u>Listing Contract Addendum</u>. The Listing Agreements and Listing Contract Addendum were provided to each MLS on February 1, 2021. Their use of the forms is not mandatory, meaning each MLS can decide for itself if and when to adopt them. Members should therefore contact their MLS to confirm whether it has elected to adopt the new forms.

AIR/CRE FORMS UPDATE: The Arizona REALTORS[®] maintains an agreement with the AIR Commercial Real Estate Association which gives members the ability to purchase AIR commercial real estate forms at a discount. In September 2020, AIR released new commercial forms that have been "localized" for Arizona and reflect Arizona law. These revised forms have been well received by the Association's commercial practitioners.

PROFESSIONAL & BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT

BUSINESS SERVICES & TECHNOLOGY

HOUSING REPORTS: In August of last year, The National Association of REALTORS[®] Advocacy Group, led by Bill Malkasian, collaborated on a joint program with State Associations such as ours and RPR to create a Housing Report of market activity, at both U.S. Congressional District and statewide U.S. Senate levels. Arizona REALTORS[®] was the first state association to gain access to these reports through cooperation with all of Arizona's MLS boards. NAR will use this as a resource for policy and advocacy activities before Congress. The up-to-date, targeted information will allow NAR staff, FPCs and Arizona REALTORS[®] staff to provide real-time examples of market activity, helping to enhance NAR and Arizona REALTORS[®] policy positions and priorities.

Although the targeted audience is members of the U.S. Senate, House of Representatives, their in-district and D.C. staff, Congressional Leadership and Committee staff, we feel that this is also a great resource for our members. Our website now includes an Arizona Housing Report button where our members will find the latest report, updated monthly.

ESIGN: Effective Saturday, May 1st, 2021, the Arizona REALTORS[®] eSign member benefit program will undergo the following changes.

- Unlimited use of Arizona REALTORS[®] eSign member accounts: accounts currently used by members will be converted to free, limited use accounts, which will continue to allow members to access all of their files and current signing sessions.
- The free plan offers 5 signing sessions <u>per month</u>; however, each session will only allow 1 document and 1 signer per session.
- Discounted rates for unlimited use access for Arizona REALTORS[®] members will be available starting at \$120 per year for individual users. Bulk and Broker accounts will also be available.
- Arizona REALTORS[®] will continue to provide unlimited use of the Lone Wolf Transactions Authentisign program as a member benefit.

TRANSACTION DESK TRAINING: The state association offers various training options:
