RAPAC SILENT AUCTION

Arizona REALTORS® **Annual RAPAC Silent Auction** is scheduled for the end of this month – **beginning on March 28th and closing on April 1st**. The Legislative Committee is still looking for more items to help raise the total from last year. HOUSING REPORTS

Arizona REALTORS® was the first state association to gain access to the REALTORS Property Resource (RPR) to create an Arizona Housing Report of market activity. This was accomplished through cooperation with each Arizona MLS. **The association's website includes an "Arizona Housing Report" button on the homepage so members can access the latest report. The reports will be updated monthly.**

Additionally, NAR will use these reports for policy and advocacy activities before Congress. The up-to-date, targeted information will allow NAR staff, FPCs and Arizona REALTORS® staff to provide real-time examples of market activity, helping to enhance NAR and Arizona REALTORS® policy positions and priorities.

2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION:

The REALTORS® have been meeting with legislators in the House to discuss our bill, [HB2172](#), which will head to the House Commerce Committee this week and expect unanimous support. From there the bill will head to the House floor for Committee of the Whole and Third Read votes before heading to the Senate.

Other bills the REALTORS® are supporting:

HB2151: Land Division; Acting in Concert

HB2101: Electric Energy; Reliability; Public Policy

HB2275: Condominium Termination; Unit Owners; Percentage

HB2598/SB1372: Transportation tax; Election; Maricopa County

RISK MANAGEMENT

Please notify General Counsel Scott Drucker of any risk management issues your members are experiencing in your region.

FORMS:

On February 1st, the following forms were released for use by all members:

- Revised Commercial Property Owner's Association Addendum.
- Revised Solar Addendum.
- New to all Arizona MLSs:
 - (i) Vacant Land/Lot Listing Contract Exclusive Right to Sell/Rent; and
 - (ii) Vacant Land/Lot Listing Contract Exclusive Agency.

No MLS is required to use any of the listing contracts prepared by the Arizona REALTORS®, but the forms are nonetheless available to them. REALTORS® should therefore check with their local MLS to see if and when their MLS will choose to adopt the Arizona REALTORS® listing contracts.

BUYER ADVISORY:

The Buyer Advisory was updated in March 2022 to include the following verbiage under Section 2, subsection 1 titled "Repairs, Remodeling and New Construction":

A contractor's license is required for work performed on a property unless the aggregate contract price, including labor and material, is less than \$1,000, the work performed is of a "casual or minor nature," and no building permit is required.

An unlicensed property owner may also perform work themselves if the property is intended for occupancy solely by the owner. If, however, the property is listed or offered for sale or rent within one year of the completed work, it is considered prima facie evidence that the owner performed the work for purposes of sale or rent.

Owners of property who are acting as developers, who improve structures or appurtenances to structures on their property for the purpose of sale or rent, and who contract with a licensed general contractor must identify the licensed contractors' names and license numbers in all sales documents.

Additionally, a workgroup has been formed to update the Seller's Property Disclosure Statement.

PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS:

In 2021 we received **209** ethics complaints and **29** arbitration requests. In total, we held **71** hearings.

So far this year we received **40** ethics complaints and **4** arbitration requests. In total, we held **10** hearings.

AIR/CRE Forms Update:

The Arizona REALTORS® maintains an agreement with the AIR Commercial Real Estate Association which gives members the ability to purchase AIR commercial real estate forms at a discount. In September 2020, AIR released new commercial forms that have been "localized" for Arizona and reflect Arizona law. These revised forms have been well received by the Association's commercial practitioners.

The Arizona REALTORS® is pleased to announce that our SSO platform will now allow members to save their initial login password. If you have not had a chance to try out Single Sign-On, we encourage you to give it a try. Members tell us, "I have a tough time remembering all of my passwords!" With SSO, remembering passwords just got a whole lot easier and the Arizona REALTORS® offers the SSO platform as part of your member benefits.

The Arizona REALTORS® SSO provides you with a customized landing page. From there, you simply click a button to get into many of the different Real Estate platforms that you use every day, including aaronline.com, Transaction Desk, zipForm®, RPR, and

participating MLSs, all without having to separately login to these accounts because after your initial login, SSO does it for you!

ZIPFORM® MEMBER BENEFIT:

Effective December 31, 2021, the National Association of REALTORS® (NAR) Lone Wolf Transactions zipForm® Edition (zipForm) free member benefit ended.

On January 1, 2022, zipForm® was **converted to an optional yearly subscription plan**. The Arizona REALTORS® will continue to license its forms to zipForm®, enabling members who choose to independently subscribe to zipForm® to access updated versions of the Association's forms. The license agreement will continue through 2022.

In addition to TransactionDesk® and zipForm®, members can also access Arizona REALTORS® forms by purchasing subscriptions to other platforms such as: Brokermint, DocuSign, dotloop, and SkySlope. Access to the Jointly and Propy platforms are expected to be available sometime during the first quarter of the year.

ESIGN:

In May 2021, the Arizona REALTORS® eSign member benefit program was converted to **free, limited use** accounts, which allowed members to continue accessing their files and signing sessions. The free plan offers:

- **5 signing sessions per month**; however, each session will only allow 1 document and 1 signer per session.
- Discounted rates for unlimited use access for Arizona REALTORS® members starting at **\$120 per year for individual users**. (*Bulk and Broker accounts are also available.*) Contact esignsupport@constellation1.com for more information.
